## **CONTESTANT INFORMATION, RULES & REGISTRATION**

The 4<sup>th</sup> Annual “Get Your Cook-On” BBQ Cook-Off is a fundraiser for the Cowboy Capital Rodeo Assn Youth College Scholarship Fund and is sanctioned by Lone Star Barbecue Society.

COOKS WILL TURN IN THEIR ENTRIES AT THE PAVILION LOCATED IN THE CENTER OF THE MANSFIELD RV PARK. CCRA WILL TRANSPORT THE ENTRIES TO THE JUDGES FROM THERE.

### **Registration**

- ★ Registration entry fee is \$100.00 per team for 3 meats and is due at the time of registration.
- ★ Team name and conduct must be appropriate for a family audience. The first contestant to register a team name will be able to use that name during the contest.
- ★ A \$25.00 fee will apply to all declined or NSF payments.
- ★ Entry fees can be paid with a credit card; please call to make arrangements.

### **Team Spaces** (Two areas are available in Mansfield RV Park)

#### 1. Designated Cook-Off Area - Open Spaces

- ★ All spaces of the designated cook-off area are open; please occupy only a 40’ X 40’ space.
- ★ All open spaces are on a “first-come, first-taken” basis. No reservations are taken.
- ★ No electricity is available in the open spaces. Generators are permitted; must be quiet.
- ★ All open spaces are free to cook-off teams.
- ★ There is limited shade in this area.

#### 2. Reserved RV Spaces

- ★ Limited RV hookups are available w/water & electricity.
- ★ RV hookups are available thru [banderarodeo@hotmail.com](mailto:banderarodeo@hotmail.com) or may be indicated on your entry form how many nights a RV site is needed. Cost is \$15 per night. Please include RV site fees with entry fees.
- ★ You may request a particular RV space. There will be no guaranty that you will receive that site, but we will make every effort to insure you receive your request. Preferential parking for large motor homes or RVs will be taken into consideration.
- ★ Vehicles and equipment must be parked in the RV space reserved. No parking in the grass area of the RV Park will be allowed by county park manager.

## PLEASE NOTE:

- ★ Each team is responsible for temporary toilets, water, trash containers, etc, in their space. Portable toilet rentals are available thru Buddy's at 830-796-3878. Public restroom w/showers are available.
- ★ No two-story structures are permitted.
- ★ Team is responsible for the cleanup of their space or spaces by Sunday May 29<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 PM. Trash must be placed in dumpsters; grease and coals must be disposed of in designated area.
- ★ No ground fires or holes are permitted.

## Team Load-In

- ★ Team and equipment load-in begins on Wednesday, May 25th @ 9:00 AM.
- ★ **Vehicles must follow speed limit signs posted in Mansfield Park.**
- ★ Violators may face disqualification from the contest and participation in any future contest.

## Jackpot Rules (Saturday)

- ★ The jackpot contest provides cash payouts for the top three places in each category.
- ★ Jackpot entries must be purchased at the time of registration for \$25.00 each.
- ★ "Best In The West" Beans category is an open pinto bean contest. Beans can be pre-soaked.
- ★ "Think Yours Is The Best?" Meat category is an open meat category that includes any type of meat except a fully jointed half chicken, beef brisket or pork spare ribs.
- ★ Buckin' Bloody Mary category is an open Bloody Mary contest that includes any type of alcohol, olives/celery/etc and spices.

## BBQ Contest Rules (Saturday)

- ★ **A mandatory Chief Cook's meeting will be held at 8:00 AM Saturday** at the Pavilion located in the RV Park. Trays, numbering system and procedures will be discussed at the meeting.
- ★ Each team must have its own pit and chief cook.
- ★ **Meat inspections will be conducted on Friday from 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM**
- ★ **Any contest meat found pre-marinated or pre-seasoned will be confiscated by the CCRA.**
- ★ Three places will be awarded in each meat category. (Beef Brisket, Pork Spare Ribs & Chicken). Grand and Reserve Grand Champion will be decided based solely on meat categories.

## Turn in Times

Turn in times are as follows for Saturday:

- ★ Buckin' Bloody Mary Jackpot 9:00 am
- ★ Best In The West Jackpot Beans 10:00 am
- ★ Think Yours is The Best? Jackpot Meat 11:00 am
- ★ Chicken 12:00 noon (1 fully-jointed half chicken containing breast portion, leg, thigh & wing)
- ★ Pork Spare Ribs 1:30 pm (7 full port spare ribs)
- ★ Brisket 3:00pm (7 slices-1/4" to 3/8" thick)

## Awards (Saturday)

- ★ The awards ceremony will be held at the judging area (Rec Hall) on Saturday at 5:00 PM. The Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion awards will be handed out during intermission of the rodeo (approximately 9:00 p.m.).
- ★ Prizes are as follows:

**Grand Champion** (Most Combined Points from Meat Categories)

Championship Buckle, Banner, Free Spot For 2012 & Cash Payout

**Reserve Grand Champion**

Reserve Champion Buckle, Banner & Cash Payout

**1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> Place Meat Categories**

Cash Payout & Banner

**1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> Jackpot Categories** (Bloody Mary, Open Meat, Beans)

100% Cash Payout; 50/30/20

- ★ “Goodie” bags will be given to each cook-off team.
- ★ Each Head Cook will be given two complimentary PRCA rodeo tickets good for any night of the rodeo. Cook-off team members may purchase rodeo tickets for half-price. Limit two per member and must show cook-off wristband to be eligible.

Film, video, audio, or other recording of the event for commercial purposes is not permitted without the prior written consent of the CCRA.
