YOU MUST:

1. Have a permanent Bandera County address;
2. Have completed at least 30 hours of college work or one-half (1/2) of trade school course and have a GPA of 2.5 or better. Please submit a copy of current transcript showing proof of hours and GPA.
3. Enroll as a full-time student taking 12 or more hours. Please provide proof of enrollment in an accredited university or trade school for Fall semester of 2011.
3. Participate in rodeos or other agricultural related events.
4. Previous and first-time scholarship recipients will be required to dedicate a small amount of time to help with the 2012 CCRA Memorial Weekend Rodeo as an additional criteria for receiving a CCRA Scholarship. Acceptance of a 2011 CCRA Scholarship will signify your willingness to help with the CCRA Rodeo in 2012. The dates are May 25, 26 & 27, 2012. A director will contact you about helping prior to the rodeo.

PURPOSE OF CCRA:

The purpose of the CCRA scholarships is to provide funds for continuing college/trade school educational goals.
